REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL IN PURSUANCE OF  
SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 849 (1993)

Addendum

1. In my report to the Security Council of 6 August 1993 (S/26250), I indicated in paragraph 16 that I would submit, as soon as possible, an addendum to the report stating the financial and administrative implications of the operation as described in paragraphs 12 and 13 of the report.
2. Should the Security Council decide to authorize the establishment of the United Nations Observer Mission in Georgia (UNOMIG), it is estimated that the total cost for a six-month period would amount to \$16,195,000 gross and would consist of 88 military observers, 56 international and 46 local civilian staff. The monthly cost thereafter would amount to \$1,950,000 gross. A breakdown of the estimated cost by main categories of expenditure is provided for information purposes in the annex to the present addendum.
3. It would be my recommendation to the General Assembly, should the Security Council decide to establish the United Nations Observer Mission in Georgia, that the costs relating thereto should be considered an expense of the Organization to be borne by Member States in accordance with Article 17, paragraph 2, of the Charter of the United Nations and that the assessments to be levied on Member States should be credited to a special account to be established for this purpose.
